



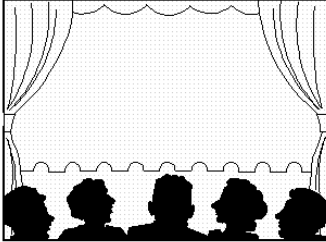

We hope that every Beaver, Cub, Scout, young leader & leaders will be able to join us at this event.

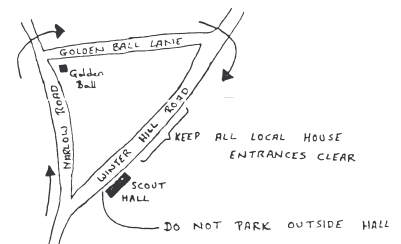
ONE-WAY SYSTEM

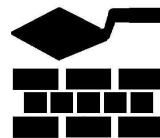
